In accordance with your request, the following includes our answers to the questions provided:

#### 1. Please describe your firm's general approach to Geotechnical Engineering.

Our philosophy is to take advantage of our local Austin Region knowledge of subsurface conditions and regional construction practices to assist in the development of geotechnical engineering study scopes for our clients. RK performs geotechnical engineering field services under the direction of a licensed, professional geotechnical engineer utilizing professional and experienced field staff; performs laboratory testing in our accredited laboratories with certified laboratory personnel; and assigns qualified junior and experienced senior staff members to perform engineering evaluation and reporting. Over the past 51 years, RK has developed localized knowledge of what works and what does not when it comes to underground construction in our regional practice areas, and uses this experience to develop constructible and cost effective solutions in coordination with the design team.

As professionals, it is our goal to make sure we understand the owner's performance criteria, utilizing this information to assist the design team in developing final, cost effective recommendations for the project. Our experience is leveraged in assisting the owner to understand the risks and advantages of each of the considered foundation systems and make recommendations in order for the owner and their representatives to make a good educated decision when selecting a foundation system.

We also feel that coordination with the design team and owner is critical for a successful project. For this reason, we commonly submit draft reports to members of the design team when their designs will be impacted by our recommendations. This allows the design team to review the information, request clarifications, and if necessary consider other alternatives for foundation and pavement design. Once this review process is completed, RK can incorporate any revisions and clarifications into a final geotechnical engineering report.

Furthermore, we believe it is critical that RK participate in pre-design meetings with the Architect, Structural Engineer, Mechanical Engineer, Civil Engineer, and Construction Manager, if they have been selected. This allows RK to provide input into the design process that could improve the performance of the foundation system and pavements, to further educate the team of the risks related to the preliminary plans, or provide more comprehensive feedback to ensure the recommendations are appropriate to the overall team approach. Finally, we believe that it is critical that RK review the specific plans and specifications that are

relevant to the geotechnical engineering recommendations and indicate to the design team whether the plans and specifications were developed consistent with the geotechnical engineering recommendations.

## 2. Who would you assign as the geotechnical engineer of record for this work? What are his or her qualifications and number of years employed by your firm?

Our Principal in Charge for the Project will be Gabriel Ornelas, Jr., PE, while our Project Manager (Geotechnical Engineer of Record) will be Yvonne Thomas, P.E. With 27 years and 17 years of experience respectively, Mr. Ornelas and Ms. Thomas have worked on hundreds of K-12 projects, combined. (Resumes are attached)

**3.** Does your firm require a limitation of liability and, if so, what is that requirement? No, for K-12 work, RK does not require a limitation of liability.

#### 4. Does your firm typically have a PE or EIT from your firm onsite when boring/sampling?

Yes, our firm has an EIT or a degreed geologist onsite. Additionally, an EIT and/or engineer will perform a secondary review of the recovered samples in the laboratory to improve the depiction of the boring logs and make laboratory test assignments.

## 5. Does your firm perform drilling with your firm's equipment and staff more often than subcontracting drilling on projects?

RK subcontracts all of the drilling operations, but all drilling operations are under the direct supervision and direction of RK professional loggers. Previously we utilized our own equipment; however, we determined that subcontracting these services allowed us to be more responsive and provided a more cost effective option for our clients. With over 60 drilling rigs under contract in the State of Texas, RK is able to respond quickly to our client's needs. All drilling rigs and subcontractors have been inspected and preapproved through our Quality Management System (QMS) process prior to entering into a subcontractor relationship. Additionally, all subcontract driller and field personnel have gone through our background checks, and have reviewed and signed off on our health and safety procedures.

## 6. How many method(s) does your firm typically use to estimate potential vertical movements of expansive soil, and what are those methods?

RK can perform three methods to estimate expansive, soil-related movements. In the Texas marketplace, the two most common methods are direct calculations based on swell testing and empirical correlations based on Atterberg Limits utilizing TxDOT Tex-124-E. An additional common method includes soil suction testing utilizing Lytton's model.

## 7. Is your firm capable of measuring soil suction without subcontracting this service, if your firm thinks this is appropriate?

Yes, RK can perform soil suction testing and does so routinely.

## 8. Is your firm capable of measuring soluble sulfate levels without subcontracting this service, if your firm thinks this is appropriate?

Yes, RK can perform sulfate testing utilizing the TxDOT Tex-145-E test and does so routinely. Our laboratory personnel who perform this testing are SB103 certified as required by TxDOT to perform this testing.

## 9. Is your firm capable of installing and monitoring piezometers without subcontracting this service, if your firm thinks this is appropriate?

Yes, RK has personnel who possess the State of Texas Monitor Well's installer's license, but we do subcontract the drilling services. RK installs hundreds of piezometers yearly on our projects.

Yes, our professional field staff are capable of performing periodic measurements of groundwater levels overtime. Prior to performing these measurements, the piezometers are sufficiently developed to remove any drilling fluid or materials that may alter seepage rates or groundwater levels.

## 10. Is your firm capable of providing construction dewatering recommendations (well point locations, depths, and pump requirements) without subcontracting this service, if this service is requested from your firm?

Yes. RK, Gabriel Ornelas, P.E. and Yvonne Thomas, P.E., specifically, have experience in developing construction dewatering recommendations. In addition, RK also has an internal Hydro-Geologist (lead by Rick Klar, PG) with extensive experience in estimating hydraulic conductivity and other pertinent information.

## 11. Is your firm capable of designing an underground water collection system to permanently dewater a site (e.g. to protect a building), without subcontracting this service, if this service is requested from your firm?

Yes. RK, Gabriel Ornelas, P.E. and Yvonne Thomas, P.E., have designed these systems on multiple projects, including on K-12 projects.

#### 12. Has your firm ever recommended ACIP piles before?

Yes. RK, Gabriel Ornels, P.E. and Yvonne Thomas, P.E., specifically, have recommended ACIP piles, including for K-12 projects.

#### 13. Has your firm ever recommended slurry-displaced piers?

Yes. RK, Gabriel Ornelas, P.E. and Yvonne Thomas, P.E., specifically, have recommended slurry-displaced piers, including for K-12 projects.

## 14. Can your firm perform design-phase load-testing of piers and/or ACIP piles if requested by the District, so that your firm would subcontract a construction firm to install the test piers/piles?

Yes. RK can perform design-phase load-testing.

### 15. In general, how long does it take for your firm to produce a final soil report after receiving Notice to Proceed for an investigation that requires 2 borings?

For a two-boring job, our typical turn-around time would be 3 weeks. However, RK has over 50 geotechnical personnel in the State of Texas with five accredited/certified laboratories. We can provide (and routinely provide) expedited services if required for a project. Under these scenarios, getting access to the borings and obtaining utility clearance and/or digging permits, if required, are typically the critical factors.

16. As part of your approach, will your firm provide a professional opinion of the "recommended allowable PVM" for this project based on discussion with the District's Representative, the Architect and

the Structural Engineer, providing examples of typical problems and typical remediation approaches that the Geotechnical Engineer associates with varying levels of estimated PVM for projects similar to this project, and informing the District during the discussion how likely it is in their opinion that the actual vertical movements could exceed the estimated PVM on this project?

Yes. RK will provide our professional opinion in this regard and has utilized this design methodology recently on projects where Huckabee was the designer. It is our opinion that this method has been an effective way to develop final recommendations for the project. Based on our extensive experience with K-12 projects, knowledge of the local conditions, and past experience with evaluating distressed structures, RK would be pleased to advise the district and their design representatives of the probable risks.

- 17. As part of your approach, will your firm submit a draft report, that is ready to be sealed, to all design professionals with scopes impacted by the report (including but not limited to the Architect, Structural Engineer, Mechanical Engineer and Civil Engineer) as well as the Construction Manager (if applicable), answer questions, and edit the report if clarifications are appropriate before the sealed report is issued? Yes. RK will utilize this approach, and has also utilized this approach on several past projects working with Huckabee. This is considered our standard, recommended approach on projects and supports collaboration and open dialogue.
- 18. As part of your firm's approach, will the Geotechnical Engineer of Record attend a meeting with the District, the Architect and other Engineers to discuss your final soil report after it is issued, as part of your firm's base services?

Yes. This is also our standard, recommended approach on projects and supports collaboration and open dialogue.

19. As part of your firm's approach, will the Geotechnical Engineer of Record review all construction plans and specification for conformance with your firm's recommendations, and provide written comments within one week of receiving sealed construction documents, as part of your firm's base services?

Yes. This is also our recommended approach with one clarification on reviewing "all construction plans and specifications". RK typically reviews only those construction plans and specifications that are applicable to our geotechnical engineering recommendations, but do include architectural, landscape architectural, mechanical, civil and structural components, at a minimum.

20. As part of your firm's approach, will your firm provide all recommended construction phase geotechnical engineering services regardless whether or not your firm is selected to provide Construction Materials Engineering, as part of your firm's base services?

Yes. These services will be billed on an hourly basis as needed during construction. As a part of our base costs, RK will provide a recommended budget for these services but will only invoice for actual hours required on the project.
