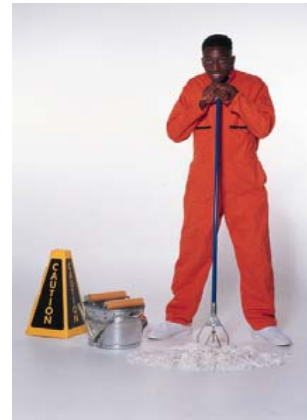

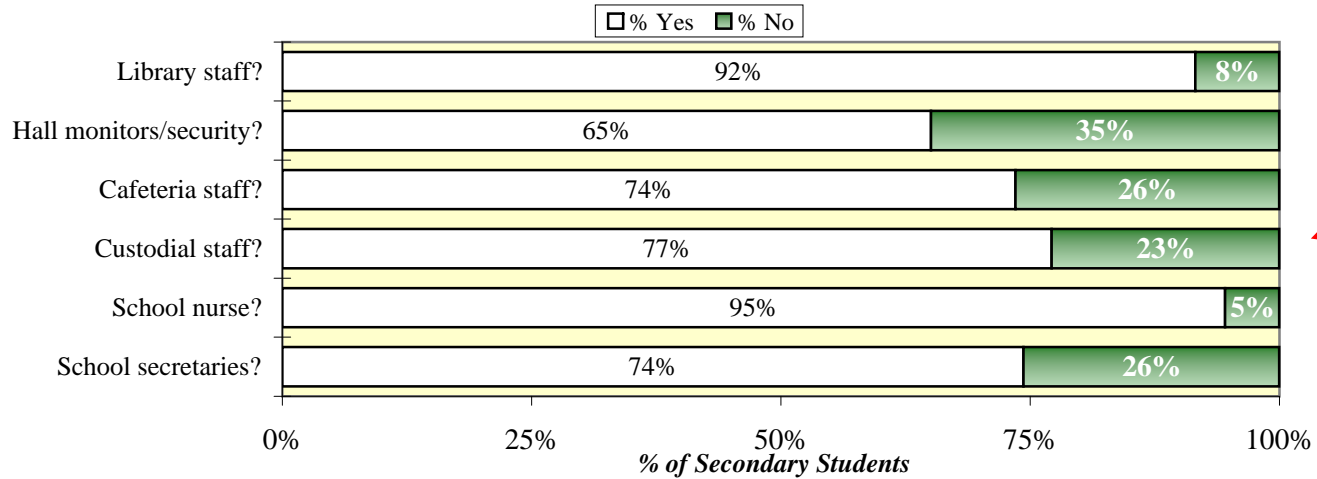

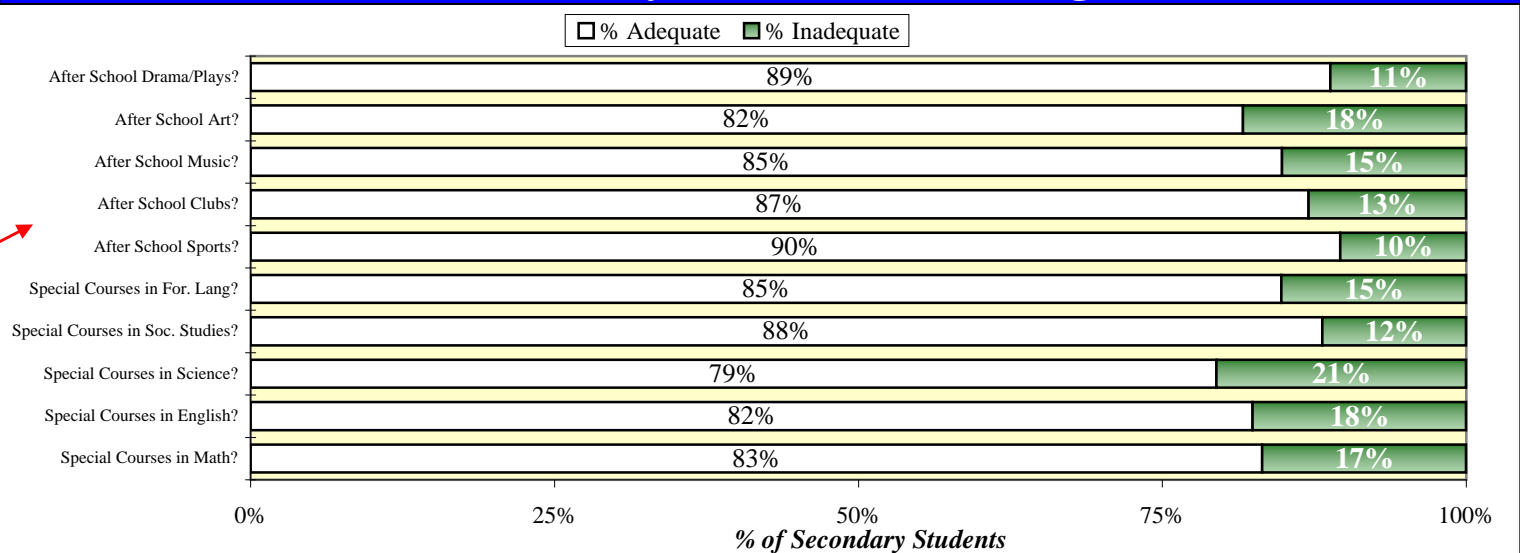
# RATINGS OF OTHER AREAS: SECONDARY STUDENTS

This graph shows the % of students who report that other types of school staff are helpful to them.

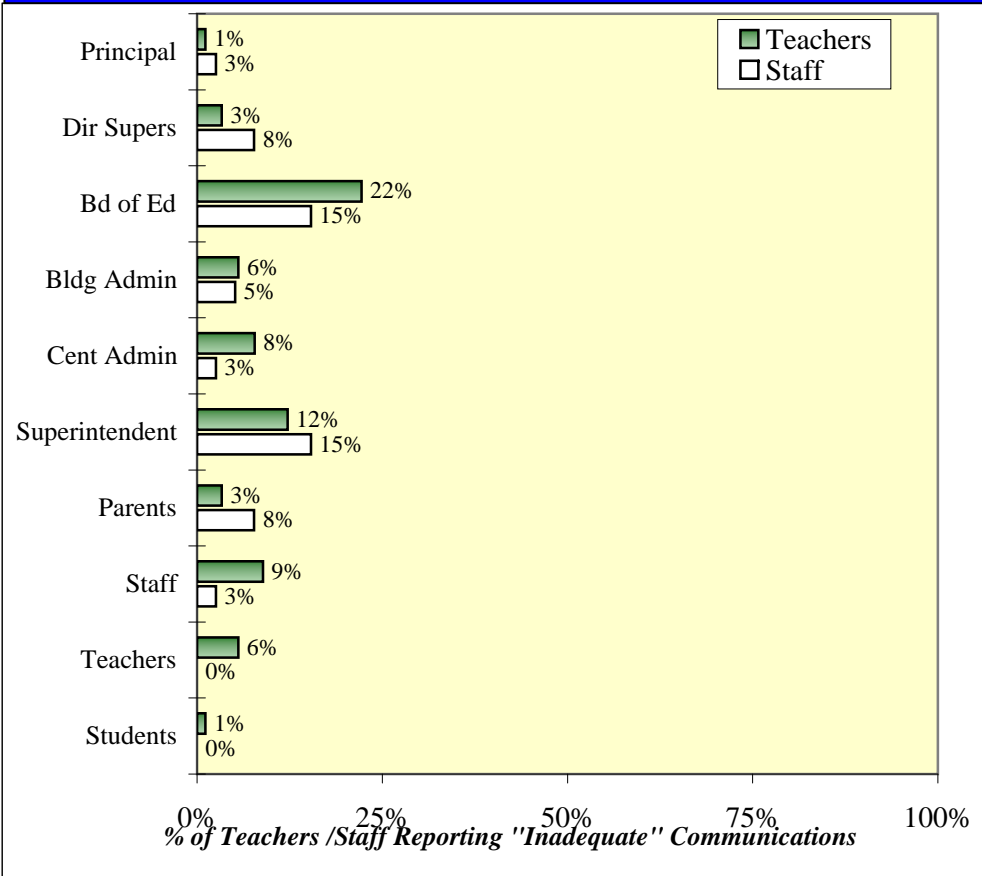
## How would you rate the following?



Extracurriculars and Electives can be an important part of a student's school experience. Students were asked to rate the availability of these opportunities.

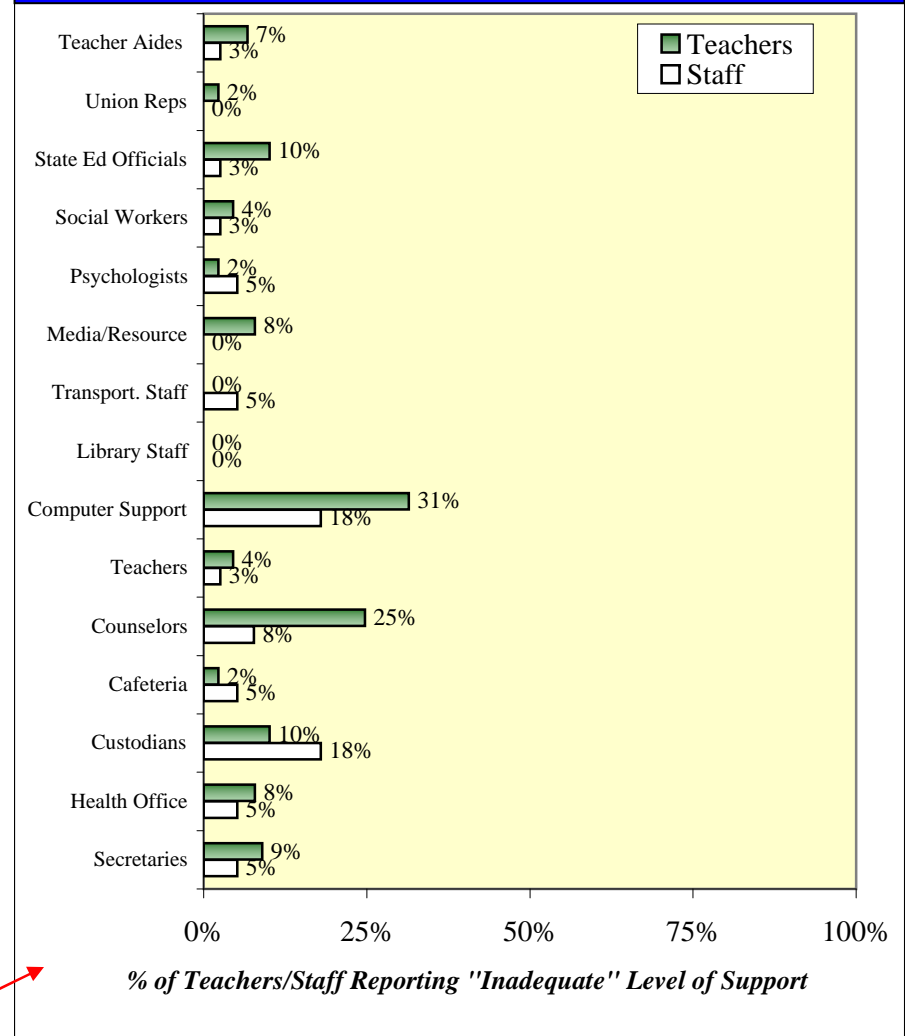
# OTHER AREAS: TEACHERS/STAFF
