DISTRICT COMMITMENT TO PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Our fourth commitment compels us to examine professional development in Lago Vista ISD and look for areas of improvement. We know that professional learning is most useful for improving instruction when it occurs in real time when participants can meet specific needs. We also know that it is most effective when participants are able to participate in professional learning that is in a focused environment, free from the distractions of day-to-day school business.

To meet these needs, Lago Vista ISD will continue to use Professional Development Exchange days. By providing for Professional Development Exchange days, LVISD will allow and encourage our instructional staff to pursue professional learning when it is most appropriate for them. Furthermore, exchange days allow teachers to participate in self-selected activities that are differentiated to meet their individual needs.

EXCHANGE DAYS FOR TEACHERS, LIBRARIANS, & SPECIALISTS

Exchange days allow teachers to complete 12 hours of professional development during the year in exchange for an equal number of hours off at the end of the year. This year, the District will be closed for instructional staff on the following two (2) Professional Development Exchange Days:

Monday, February 19, 2018 Thursday, May 31, 2018

- ✓ In exchange for the 2 days off in the spring, teachers, librarians, and specialists must complete professional development equaling 12 total credit hours during non-contractual time.
- ✓ 12 credit hours are satisfied by successfully completing subject-area instruction training, as required by the Texas Education Agency.
- ✓ Exchange hours may be accumulated by attending professional development summer sessions, online sessions, or after-school sessions. A variety of options are included in this document. <u>All</u> exchange hours must be completed during non-contractual or non-work time.
- ✓ Only training endorsed or approved by the District will fulfill requisite professional development exchange hours. Outside training may be considered for credit if approved by campus administration.
- ✓ Professional development exchange credit hours may be accumulated between June 1, 2017 and February 2, 2018. Instruction-related summer training satisfies exchange credit hours (i.e., AP Summer Institute, OnRamps, etc.).
- ✓ All training must be documented with certificates and supplied to campus administration.

Campus & district administrators, counselors, office support staff, and other non-exempt, non-instructional timeclock employees scheduled to work on February 19 and May 31 will work <u>as</u> **scheduled**.

EXCHANGE DAYS FOR INSTRUCTIONAL PARAPROFESSIONALS

Employees serving as instructional paraprofessionals have the option to use a Non-Duty day in lieu of working on an Exchange Day or to accumulate and use 8 hours of Comp Time for each Exchange Day. Instructional paraprofessionals must complete 16 hours of comp time prior to August 14, 2017 in exchange for an equal number of hours off at the end of the year. This year, the District will be closed for instructional staff on the following two (2) Professional Development Exchange Days:

Monday, February 19, 2018 Thursday, May 31, 2018

- ✓ In exchange for the 2 days off in the spring, instructional paraprofessionals may use a non-duty day or may earn comp time equaling 16 total hours during non-duty time.
- ✓ Comp time hours that will be used for exchange days must be earned prior to August 14, 2017.
- ✓ Comp time for exchange days may be accumulated by attending professional development summer sessions or by completing other pre-approved work-related activities. <u>All comp time for</u> exchange hours must be completed during non-work time prior to August 14, 2017.
- ✓ All training and/or activities to be used to earn comp time must be approved by your supervisor and must be documented with certificates and supplied to the appropriate administration. Instructional paraprofessionals in Special Education should have these activities approved by the Director of Special Education/504, Krystal Colhoff. Instructional paraprofessionals working in all other programs, including general education and Title I, should work with the campus administrator to have these activities approved.

Campus & district administrators, counselors, office support staff, and other non-exempt, non-instructional timeclock employees scheduled to work on February 19 and May 31 will work <u>as</u> **scheduled**.

COURSE OPTIONS TO FULFILL EXCHANGE HOURS

Employees eligible for exchange hours have an infinite array of professional development options to fulfill exchange hours. What follows are selected options for content-area exchange hour credit. This is not an exhaustive list, so if you are aware of another opportunity, it may still be approved for exchange hours. All exchange hour professional development activities must be selected with principal approval.

Since this professional development is replacing workdays at the end of the year, the only additional stipulation is that the staff development activities occur during non-contractual time. You are likely to participate in staff development that occurs during your work hours or that do not specifically address instruction for your content area. While those activities are very worthwhile and encouraged, they do not satisfy the exchange hour requirement.

In order to receive credit for exchange hours for outside trainings/workshops, certificates must be uploaded, and "exchange hour" credit must be requested in Workshop (Eduphoria!). **Note: It is crucial that you specifically request exchange credit in this process!**

IN-DISTRICT SUMMER TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES THAT SATISFY EXCHANGE HOURS

All exchange opportunities must be approved through your campus principal or supervisor using a PD Request form. [See Appendix] Course certificates for in-district trainings are automatically awarded through Eduphoria and do not need to be requested. Please remember that you must submit your certificates for these compliance trainings through Eduphoria. Please submit them as one request for 7 hours and attach all 7 certificates.

- Remember to select "Mandatory Training" as the type of credit.
- Enter the Title as "Mandatory Compliance Videos 2017".
- The deadline to complete the videos is August 31, 2017.
- The deadline to request credit in Eduphoria is September 15, 2017.

These procedures are important because they allow principals to pull a report to verify completion, rather than having to review each employee's portfolio individually.






6. Enter the as the title of your entry. You may leave the description blank. Click "Next" at the bottom on the right.



7. Select the date of your training. The default time is 8:00am. Please select the time your training began. Click "Next" at the bottom on the right.




8. Select the date your training ended. The default end time is 4:00pm. Select the time your training ended. Click "Next" at the bottom on the right.




9. Select "Yes", you would like to request district credit for this entry. Click "Next" at the bottom on the right.









- 13. On your Workshop portfolio page, select the entry you just created.




14. Select the second tab, entitled "Notes".




15. At the bottom on the right, select the paperclip icon to add files.

IMPORTANT REMINDER:

In order for certificates to qualify for Exchange Days, you MUST select "Exchange Credit Hours" for these courses.

In order to be counted as a "completer" for the Mandatory Compliance Videos, you MUST select "Compliance Training Credit Hours" when you submit your certificates.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT EXCHANGE DAYS

What are Exchange Days?

Exchange Days are a way to exchange district required professional development time for two designated days off during the school year. Rather than requiring instructional employees to be physically present for two 6-hour days of professional development, those employees accumulate an equivalent number of hours outside of the regular workday and substitute the hours for the designated professional development days on the calendar.

What is the purpose of Exchange Days?

Exchange Days promote appropriate and effective professional learning for all instructional staff by allowing professional development activities to be selected based on personal learning needs related to specific content areas. Instructional staff, with approval from their campus administrator, select professional development activities that best contribute to their own professional growth.

Who is required to earn credit for Exchange Days?

Teachers, instructional specialists, nurses, and librarians.

Who is not eligible to earn credit for Exchange Days?

Administrators, counselors, office support staff, and other non-exempt, non-instructional time clock employees. These employees will work on June 1st and June 2nd as scheduled.

How many hours of Exchange Credit do I need to earn?

Eligible employees must earn credit for two contract days, or 12 hours of professional development credit. Six hours of professional development time is equivalent to one contract day.

When are the Exchange Days?

The Exchange Days for 2016-2017 are June 1st and June 2nd. The District will be closed for instructional staff on those days.

When does my Professional Development Exchange Credit have to be completed?

Teachers must submit all credit requests for Professional Development Exchange Time to their campus supervisors on or before April 3, 2017. Campus principals must submit the list of employees who have met the requirements for Exchange Days no later than April 10, 2017.

What professional development activities can be used to earn Exchange Time credit?

Eligible employees earn credit by attending professional development activities that relate directly to content-area instruction.

Can teachers participate in online professional development for Exchange Time credit?

Yes, as long as the professional development is approved by the teacher's administrator and is completed outside of the teacher's regular contract hours.

What happens if I do not earn appropriate exchange hour credit for these days? If appropriate credit hours for Exchange Days are not earned for these days, pay may be docked at your daily rate of pay in order to return the compensation received for those days. Appeals due to extenuating circumstances may be made by submitting a letter in writing to the superintendent.

What happens if I earn more than 12 professional development hours off contract?

Teachers may attend more than 12 hours of professional development, however, only 12 will count toward Exchange Day credit hours. Teachers must earn at least 12 hours to satisfy the Exchange Day requirement. All hours, including hours that count for Exchange Day credit, may count toward additional certifications or certification renewals.

If there is a fee associated with the professional development activity and the campus covers the cost of this fee, can the credit still be used for Exchange Time?

Yes, the campus can cover the cost of the professional development activity, with principal approval. However, teachers should not receive supplemental stipends when earning Exchange Time credit.

Wait! I'm an instructional paraprofessional...what about me?

Employees who work as instructional paraprofessionals may accumulate 16 hours of Comp Time to be used for the two exchange days (8 hours per day). The pre-approved work-related activities you use to earn your comp time must be pre-approved and must be completed during non-work time prior to August 15, 2017.

What if I am an instructional paraprofessional who was hired after August 15, 2017? What if I didn't complete comp time before August 15, 2017? What if I only completed 8 hours of comp time prior to August 15, 2017?

Instructional paraprofessionals have the option to use a non-duty day for the exchange day(s) or may work on the Exchange Day in order to be paid for those two days.
