

FIELD REGULATIONS

- Coaches, football team members, sports medicine staff, athletic trainers, band members, drill team members, and cheerleaders in uniform will be admitted to the field.
 - Authorized personnel ONLY allowed on field.
- Sideline access / media credentials must be requested by noon Thursday by contacting Janda Castillo (LVHS principal) or Craten Phillips (AD)
- Spectators and family members are not allowed on the field at any time before, during, or after the game.
- Tobacco, chewing gum, sunflower seeds, colored drinks, confetti, glitter, or other contaminants are prohibited.
- No glass of any kind is allowed on the field.
- No open flames or fireworks permitted.
- Halftime props must not mark or scar the field. This includes painted items as well as sharp wheels or other equipment that may damage the artificial surface. The sideline should be kept clear of any equipment that might injure an athlete.
- No motorized vehicles of any kind are allowed on the field or track without permission of the Athletic Director.
- Visiting teams to Lago Vista ISD Viking Stadium will be held responsible for negligent damages to the playing field or track.

SPORTS MEDICINE

Lago Vista ISD Athletics will have a trainer on site for games. However, we ask all teams to bring their own ice, water buckets, and squeeze bottles to fill up in our training room.

PARKING

An LVHS school representative will assist and direct visiting buses with parking

Visiting football team bus will park behind the visitor bleachers

Visiting team band /drill team / cheerleader buses will unload and park at end of stadium behind scoreboard.

Lago Vista ISD Viking Stadium Turf Field and Track Rules

The rules below are part of our plan to ensure a high-quality facility for many years to come. Head coaches, lead sponsors, and/or authorized signers of the facility use form, will be responsible for ensuring that everyone in their group are made aware of and adheres to the rules set forth by the Lago Vista ISD. Failure to abide by these rules may result in suspensions and/or revocation of the group's ability to use the complex.

The rules and guidelines are as follows:

- 1. No sports drinks, sodas, or any other drink are allowed. Water is the ONLY beverage allowed on the track surface or turf.
- 2. No food, gum or sunflower seeds on the track surface or turf.
- 3. Do not leave any trash on the turf or track surfaces. Tape, water/soda bottles, cups, clothes, etc... Please use the provided trash receptacles.
- 4. No glass of any kind is allowed inside the complex.
- 5. No canopies, tents, lawn chairs, or anything that requires staking, are allowed on the track surface or turf.
- 6. No tobacco or vaping –this is a violation of Lago Vista ISD policy and Texas state law.
- 7. No pets are allowed on the track surface or turf.
- 8. Only authorized motorized vehicles are allowed on the track surface and turf (I.E. ambulance, trainers vehicle).
- 9. Only authorized gas-powered machinery are allowed on the track surface or turf. A power generator and DC source may be placed on the field or turf only with special permission and only when a protective barrier is utilized between the power unit and the track surface and turf. Whenever possible, the machinery/power source will be placed on the outside of the track surface and turf. All power cords must be contained safely within close proximity to the equipment being used.
- 10. No pyrotechnics, fireworks or flames of any kind on the track surface or turf. Fireworks and pyrotechnics are prohibited on ALL school properties without authorization from the Superintendent.
- 11. Only rubber soled shoes and USATF/IAAF certified track shoes may be worn on the track surface.
- 12. Only grass cleats or rubber molded cleats may be worn on the turf.
- 13. No sharp, jagged, edgy, heavy or damaging materials are to be used or placed on the track surface or turf.
- 14. Follow all state, federal and local laws and policies.
- 15. The stadium and track are closed to the public without prior written consent of Lago Vista ISD.



In a continuing effort to assure the safety and enjoyment of all athletes and spectators, the following procedures will be enforced during all Lago Vista ISD athletic events:

- 1. Outside food and drink are prohibited.
- 2. There is no re-entry after exiting the event. Re-entry requires the purchase of a new ticket.
- 3. All students 5th grade and younger must be accompanied by an adult guardian and remain under the supervision of that guardian while at the event.
- 4. Standing, loitering or horseplay under and around the stands, concession stands, or any other area is prohibited. There is absolutely no standing allowed by the rails and walkways in the stands. Repeat offenders will be required to leave the event and campus.
- 5. Revealing, provocative and/or inappropriate dress will not be allowed, nor will inappropriate behaviors or foul language. Repeat offenders will be required to leave the event and campus.
- 6. The use of alcohol, controlled substances, tobacco, and electronic cigarettes are prohibited on school premises.
- 7. Only pre-approved individuals will be allowed access to the sidelines and track during football games.
- 8. Spectators may not enter the field area at any time prior, during or after the game.
- 9. Signs subject to removal by LVISD officials if deemed inappropriate or against district policy. Signs should be positive in nature. Tape may not be placed directly on rails. All signs must be removed by the visiting school at the conclusion of the game.

Lago Vista ISD appreciates everyone's cooperation and support as we work to keep a safe and enjoyable environment at Viking athletic events.
