RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

LAGO VISTA INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

COUNTY OF TRAVIS §

WHEREAS, the Help America Vote Act of 2002 (HAVA), found in 42 U.S.C. § 15481 (a)(3), mandates that for elections in which a federal office is on the ballot, each polling place must be equipped with an electronic voting machines to facilitate voting by those with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature implemented HAVA in the 2003 regular session with the passage of House Bill 1549, but expanded the scope of the electronic voting machine requirement to apply to any election held in the state, with limited exceptions; and

WHEREAS, the federal Military and Overseas Voter Empowerment Act of 2009 (MOVE), found in 42 U.S.C. § 1973ff-1, provides for an extended timetable in which absentee ballots be transmitted to uniformed and overseas citizens at least 45 days prior to an election; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature implemented the MOVE Act in 2011 with the passage of Senate Bill 100, which overlaid the period between the state's primary and primary runoff election upon the most commonly-used uniform election date for school district trustees, junior college district trustees, and municipal general elections, which is the second Saturday in May; and

WHEREAS, section 11.0581 of the Texas Education Code provides that an election for trustees of an independent school district shall be held on the same date as: (1) the election for the members of the governing body of a municipality located in the school district; (2) the general election for state and county officials; (3) the election for the members of the governing

body of a hospital district; or (4) the election for members of the governing board of a public community college district in which the school district is wholly or partly located; and

WHEREAS, many counties in Texas have concluded that, in May of even-numbered years (the years in which the state's primary and primary runoff elections are held), they will be unable to provide to their school districts, cities, hospital districts and junior college districts – through sharing, lease, or other means – the electronic voting machines that are required by the aforementioned federal and state laws; and

WHEREAS, the Lago Vista Independent School District currently holds its general election jointly with the City of Lago Vista, Texas on the uniform election date on the second Saturday in May; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lago Vista, Texas, in accordance with Senate Bill 100 and other statutory and state constitutional provisions, has resolved to conduct future elections for its governing officers annually on the November uniform election date; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the joint election requirement found in the Texas Education Code, Lago Vista Independent School District must also move its general election for its Board of Trustees to conform to the City of Lago Vista's election cycle:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the trustee terms for members of the Board of Trustees shall be extended, as permitted by law, so that trustee terms currently ending in May shall extend from May to November of the same year (eg. Trustee terms ending in May, 2011 shall extend to November, 11; trustee terms ending in May, 2012 shall extend to May, 2012, etc.); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that effective January 1, 2012, or when this election change is precleared by the Department of Justice, whichever date shall be later, that the General Election for Lago Vista Independent School District shall be conducted annually on the November uniform election date, and that the election will be held jointly with the City of Lago Vista, Texas.
