- I. **Child Abuse, Family Violence, Dating Violence and Human Trafficking** – The committee was asked to review and approve the presented material, which is also the approved Goodheart-Wilcox material adopted by the State. There was not an official quorum for the meeting and Gina will send out an email vote via google forum to ensure a true quorum.
Action item: Gina Carmichael.

- II. **Stock Naloxone for Opioid Overdose** – Naloxone is currently being stocked on all campuses where AEDs are maintained. Administration and front office staff are trained to administer the Naloxone. Teachers from MS and HS campuses have also received training on recognizing opioid overdoses. The committee viewed the educational video “Song for Charlie”, which will be presented to the High school students early this semester. The committee was tasked to discuss whether the video content is appropriate for Middle school grade level. Opioid instruction in TEKS is required for sixth grade. SHAC agreed the video content is appropriate and recommended sharing with parents along with resources and support links. Resources should include education to parents that prescriptions for Naloxone are not required and may be purchased at their local pharmacy. SHAC approves recommendation to principal to share video and educational resources with parents of Middle school students. *Action item: Gina Carmichael and Suzy Lofton-Bullis.*

- III. **Spring Health Fair** – The Spring Health Fair is scheduled for May 18th at the High school along with the annual district GT showcase. The Health Fair is put on by the SHAC committee and will include showcases from local health, fitness, and sporting vendors. Demos from new Health Science and Culinary Arts classes are included along with Stop the Bleed training from Travis County EMS.

- IV. **Open Discussion** – Angela will participate in the PE meeting. Dr. Cox and Gina will connect to discuss his participation in the PE meeting. Jeannine and Gina will collaborate on content to distribute to the teachers.
