The opportunity to travel out of town with a school-sanctioned activity is a special trip. With that opportunity comes responsibility for both the athlete and the parent/guardian. Appropriate and acceptable behavior is expected. Because safety of the entire delegation is always our first priority, rules and processes must be strictly enforced. Athletes who are unable or unwilling to comply with the rules or jeopardize the safety of others could result in the athlete being removed from the delegation and not allowed to continue participation at Chapter Summer Games for the remainder of the trip.

Whereas the coaches will work with the athletes and communicate with the family to prevent any such concerns, on rare occasions it may become necessary for an athlete to return home if the situation cannot be resolved. In that case, parents would be responsible for returning the athlete to Lago Vista.

Though we never anticipate such an event, parents and athletes must be aware that a procedure is in place for such an occasion. The athlete and family should be aware that if he/she is removed from Chapter competition due to flagrant and/or dangerous misbehavior, all future consideration for Chapter or National level trips for the athlete would be under scrutiny.

We have read this information together. We understand that rules will be clearly defined and enforced, and we agree to follow the rules and to stay with the group throughout the event. Failure to comply with the expectations may result in being removed from Chapter Summer Games participation.
